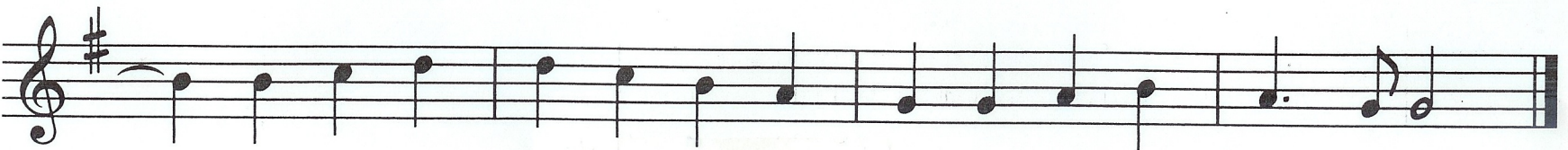
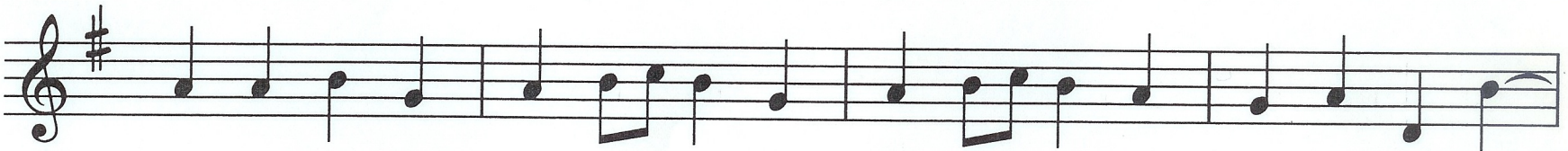


Ode To Joy

2 measures (8 beats) introduction
on recording

new rhythms:



single eighth note = $1/2$ beat

Until now, you have seen two eighth notes joined together with a beam ().
Together, two eighth notes = 1 beat.



dotted quarter note = $1 \frac{1}{2}$ beats

Again, the dot adds half the value of that note
and makes it longer.



$1 + 1/2 = 1 \frac{1}{2}$ beats
